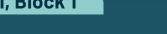

Admissions Requirements

All students must present one of the following:

- Proof of recent (within the last 2 years)
 secondary education equivalent to Year 12 in
 Australia with a minimum ATAR score of 60; OR
- Proof of completion of Vocational Education and Training (VET) study - Australian Certificate
 IV (AQF 4) or higher; OR
- Proof of Higher Education study recognised Foundation Studies course; OR
- For Mature Applicants aged 21+ who have finished secondary education more than two years ago, evidence to demonstrate a reasonable prospect of success

International students require a minimum English level of Intermediate 4 on our free proprietary Academic English Placement test (equivalent to IELTS 6.0).
